

Douglas Ray Award 2009 CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

CIESC/SCECI is issuing a call for submissions for the Douglas Ray Award to be presented at the 2009 Annual Conference. The award recognizes meritorious presentation by a Graduate student (at the Master or Doctoral level) at the CIESC Annual Conference.

PURPOSE:

The purpose of the award is to give recognition to outstanding research in the field of comparative and international education and to facilitate communication about that research. It is hoped that such recognition will encourage and stimulate further high quality research by graduate students.

CRITERIA:

The major criterion for the award is research excellence. When reviewing submissions, the CIESC/SCECI Award Committee for the Douglas Ray Award will pay special attention to: the significance of the problem and the conceptualization, design, and execution, as well as the quality of the presentation. The potential value of the research for theory development, improved practice and future research will also be considered.

ELIGIBILITY:

The candidate must have presented his or her paper as a graduate student at the CIESC 2008 Annual Conference at the University of University of British Columbia in May-June 2008.

Feature presentation at the CIESC 2009 Annual Conference.

Certificate of Accomplishment and cash award presented at the Annual Conference.

One-year free membership in CIESC.
