

## **What We Have Learned From Teacher Leaders and Teaching Volunteers**

Teacher Leaders and Teaching Volunteers found the Family Math training to be very thorough and effective in preparing them to deliver Family Math programming.

The majority of Teacher Leaders shared their Family Math teaching responsibilities with the Teaching Volunteers. They were described by the Teaching Volunteers as extremely organized, supportive, approachable, and knowledgeable.

The Teaching Volunteers, especially those training to become teachers, reported being appreciative of the opportunity to work with leaders who were excellent mentors. They plan to use their Family Math facilitation skills in future Family Math programs as well as in their own classrooms once they begin their teaching careers.

The majority of Teacher Leaders and Teaching Volunteers found their Family Math experiences to be very positive and rewarding. Many reported that they would continue their involvement in the program. Over 75 of these individuals have subsequently been trained as Family Math Coordinators.
