

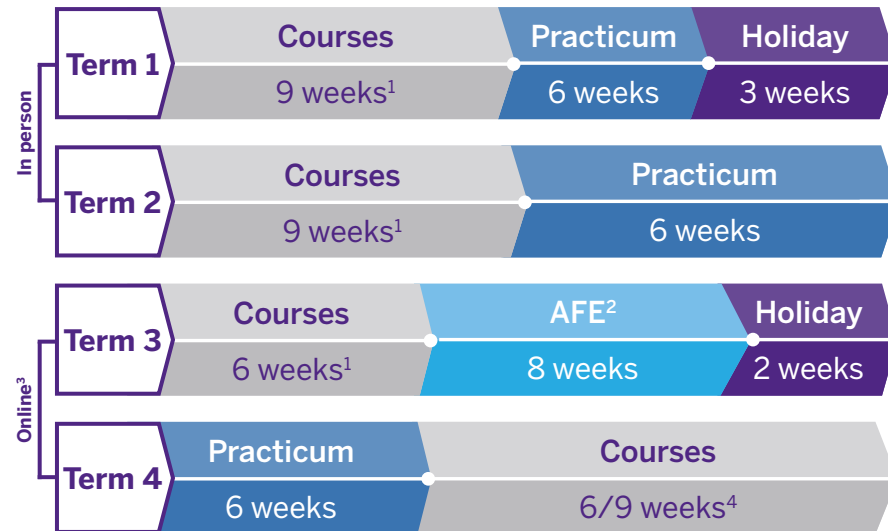
Teacher Education Program

16 MONTHS (4 TERMS) | HYBRID

Cultivate the passion, skills and heartfelt dedication that characterize teachers and leaders in education. Our 16-month Teacher Education Program is designed to address current needs in education and prepare you to become an educational leader on a global scale. A program designed to meet the evolving needs of a diverse educational community.

Upon successful completion of the program, teacher candidates will be recommended to the Ontario College of Teachers for a Certificate of Qualification and Registration, which will certify them to teach in Ontario schools. The program will start in September and end in December of the following year.

Streams, teachables and specialties

1. Choose a stream	2. Choose teachable(s) if applicable (depending on program stream)
Primary - Junior Prepare to teach all subjects, Kindergarten to Grade 6.	Preference in admissions is given to applicants with at least one(1) course in four of the six areas: English, Fine Arts, Health and Physical Education, Mathematics, Science, and Social Science/ Humanities (with preference for Canadian History/Geography).
Primary - Junior French Prepare to teach all subjects, Kindergarten to grade 6. Prepare to teach core and immersion French, Kindergarten to Grade 6.	Preference in admissions is similar to the regular Primary-Juior stream. Requires either: • Five (5) full French credits -OR- • A French proficiency test
Junior - Intermediate Prepare to teach Grades 4 to 10.	Select one teachable: French, Music - Instrumental, Music - Vocal, Religious Education
Intermediate - Senior Prepare to teach Grades 7 to 12.	Select two teachables*: Economics, English (First Language), Environmental Science, Family Studies, French (Second Language), Geography, Health & Physical Education, History, Law, Mathematics, Music – Instrumental, Music – Vocal, Philosophy, Politics, Religious Education, Science – Biology, Science – Chemistry, Science – General, Science – Physics, Social Science – General.
