Duration	1 to 2 years
Internal ORS deadline	No later than - Monday, Jan. 19, 2026 (10AM)
Sponsor deadline	No later than - Monday, Feb. 2, 2026 (10AM)
Results	June 2026 (Period: Jun. 1'26-May 31'28)
Applicant Eligibility	Affiliated* with Canadian postsecondary institution
Co-Applicant Eligibility	Canadian or International postsecondary
Collaborator Eligibility	Any individual. NB! Restricted budget.

^{*} At Western a faculty Applicant is required to have a research-eligible appointment. Postdoctoral applicants allowed, with ROLA proposal running through their research-eligible faculty Supervisor.

Scholar Type – implications


Emerging Scholars

- By default, all project ideas are 'new'.
- Required in the 'Context' section of the Detailed Description attachment to explain the relationship and relevance of the proposed research to their ongoing research. If the proposal represents a significant change of direction from your previous research, describe how it relates to experiences and insights gained from earlier research achievements.

Established Scholars

- Must be exploring new research questions and/or approaches that are distinct from the applicant's previous/ongoing research.
- Required, in a specific application text box, to clearly justify how the proposed research is distinct from their previous/ongoing research. Proposed projects should be clearly delimited and in the early stages of the research process.

IDG Evaluation Criteria*



Challenge (50%) - Proposal, Outcomes/Impacts, Training of HQP

- Aim and importance of the endeavour. The 'What".
- E.g. Originality and significance.

Capability (30%) – CVs, Past training of HQP, Past KMb activities

The expertise to succeed. The 'Who'.

Feasibility (20%) – Budget, KMb Plan, Timelines

The plan to achieve excellence. The 'How'.



Budget Considerations

- Works on principle of 'minimum essential funding'
 - Be reasonable and justify proposed expenditures
 - Relate clearly to research objectives and methodology
- Cannot remunerate anyone on the Research Team (applicant, co-applicant, collaborators). Exception: <u>Tri-agency guideline on remuneration for Indigenous</u> <u>people participating in funded projects</u>
- Funds cannot be used for Collaborator research costs (only travel and subsistence related to information exchange, planning and dissemination)
- Funds cannot be used for remuneration and/or travel and subsistence costs of presenters or guest speakers.
- Time release/course buy-outs not an eligible SSHRC request


Also Submit ROLA proposal

- Min. 2 weeks before invite Team members
- All invitations accepted and tasks (CCV) completed to submit.
- Content does not have to be final version.

- Application reviewed for Sponsor and UWO compliance.
- Compliance feedback provided.
- Application will be made accessible for edits.

- Final application must be resubmitted in the Research Portal no later than 10am on Feb. 2, 2025.
- *Highly recommend two business days in advance of Monday.

Appendix – Emerging Scholar

<u>Applicants</u> identifying themselves as an emerging scholar must demonstrate that they have not applied successfully, as principal investigator or project director, for a grant offered through SSHRC, the Natural Sciences and Engineering Research Council, or the Canadian Institutes of Health Research. Emerging scholars may, however, have previously held or currently hold knowledge mobilization grants and/or SSHRC Partnership Engage Grants.

In addition, they must meet at least one of the following criteria:

- 1. have completed their highest degree no more than six years before the competition deadline (SSHRC considers only the date of completion of the first doctorate); or
- 2. have held a tenured or tenure-track postsecondary appointment for less than six years; or
- 3. have held a postsecondary appointment, but never a tenure-track position (in the case of institutions that offer tenure-track positions); or
- 4. have had their careers significantly interrupted or delayed for health or family reasons within the past six years.

Appendix – Established Scholar

Someone who has established—or who, since the completion of his or her highest degree, has had the opportunity to establish—a record of <u>research achievement</u>.

'Record of research achievement':

Includes any identifiable contributions made by applicants to the advancement, development and mobilization of knowledge related to the disciplines supported by SSHRC.

Example of grants previously/currently held as Principal Investigator:

- SSHRC Insight Grant or Insight Development Grant
- CIHR Operating Grant
- NSERC Alliance and/or Discovery Grant
- New Frontiers in Research Funds, such as NFRF Exploration
